1206. SHRI BAIJAYANT JAY PANDA:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government intends to consider the Government of Odisha's request to implement the National Manufacturing Competitiveness Programme (NMCP) through the MSME department of the State.
- (b) if so, the detail thereof and if not the reason thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is aware that the Government of Odisha has a dedicated MSME department which has a presence throughout the State and therefore, is in a better position to implement the Centrally Sponsored Schemes of the Government ;and
- (d) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto?

- (a): Yes, the Government of India is committed to consider the proposals from all States including Odisha, as per the guidelines of the approved National Manufacturing Competitiveness Programme (NMCP) schemes.
- (b): All NMCP Schemes are demand driven. The eligible proposals under the respective scheme, received from the State of Odisha have already been approved for implementation.
- (c)&(d): Yes, Government of India works in close coordination with the Odisha MSME Department for efficient implementation of sectoral schemes.
