FUNDING PATTERN UNDER PMKSY

1571. SHRI BAIJAYANT JAY PANDA:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that the original funding pattern of 90:10 between the centre and the States for the Kalahandi Bolangir Koraput (KBK) Region in Odisha districts under the Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP) has been changed into 60:40 after the convergence of AIBP with the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY), if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has taken any steps to ensure that even under PMKSY, the funding pattern of 90:10 is maintained under the AIBP for these districts; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): After acceptance of the report of Sub-Group of Chief Ministers on Rationalization of Centrally Sponsored Schemes; constituted by NITI Aayog, the funding pattern of AIBP under Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayye Yojana (PMKSY) has been changed to (90:10 for the 8 North-Eastern and 3 Himalayan States), 60:40 for special category states and 25:75 for general category states.

After devolution of resources to States (from 32% to 42%) in the Central Divisible Pool, more resources are now available with States for completion of their projects. Therefore revision of funding pattern of (60:40) applicable to KBK region is not contemplated.
